

POLLUTION INCIDENT RESPONSE FLOW CHART


Does the pollution incident present an immediate threat to human health or property?



Notify IMMEDIATEY on 000 NSW Fire and Rescue NSW Police NSW Ambulance



Does the pollution incident constitute actual or potential material harm to the environment?



Will the remediate / clean upcost more than \$10,000



Must notify the Enviroment Protection Authority (EPA) IMMEDIATELY

Report incident as per internal incident reporting procedures

Information that must be notified

Time, date, nature, duration and location of incident

Location of the place where pollution is occuring or is likely to occur

If known, the following information must also be notified:

- Nature, estimated quantity or volum and concentration of any pollutants
- Circumstances in which the incident ocured (including the causeof the incident)
- Action taken or proposed to be taken to deal with the incident and any resulting pollution or threatened pollution
